Tips (if time) There are many different types of applications and a good way to practice is doing a trial application on the employers website and not submitting at the Help job seeker understand that filling out online applications alone is a weak way of doing an application; networking with an employer and then doing applications gets better results Understand importance of follow-up after completing an application; too much follow-up or too little follow-up can kill the relationship Question and Answer
